



The Retail / Office Blocks in the newly developed Thornaby Town Centre have been named to reflect Thornaby's past heritage. All buildings were named in consultation with Thornfield Properties and Thornaby Ward Councillors.

Block A is constructed on the former Town Centre car park and has been named **Vale House** after the Royal Flying Corps flew planes from Vale Dairy Farm during World War I. Vale Dairy Farm was later bought as one of the farms which formed the Airfield for World War II.

Block B has replaced Meynell House and been renamed **St Peter's House** due to its close proximity to St Peter's Square in the Town Centre.

Block C will replace Appleby House and will open as a LIDL supermarket in August 2009. The building will be named **Grace House** after Captain James Cook's mother, Grace Pace, who was born in Thornaby.

Block D remains **St Peter's Square**, which has been attractively repaved and is the proud location of Thornaby Market and the state of the art Market Café.
