

SAES ICT Users Policy

Before using the Stockton Adult Education Service (SAES) facilities, you are asked to read and abide by the terms of our acceptable use policy below.

The following is strictly forbidden:

The retrieval, storage, viewing, receiving, loading/uploading or posting of any material or information which is illegal in the United Kingdom or could be reasonably construed as offensive by another user or recipient.

The retrieval, storage, viewing, receiving, loading/uploading or posting of any material or information by means of e-mail or other electronic mail facilities that are illegal in the United Kingdom or could be reasonably construed as offensive by another user or recipient.

The deliberate introduction of a computer virus.

Tampering with the set-up of the PC so as to cause damage to the operating system or render it inoperable.

Use of threatening behaviour both to SAES staff and other users.

SAES will make every effort to ensure that our Internet and e-mail facilities are protected from sites of a dubious nature and from misuse.

Where SAES suspect that improper use has taken place or will take place we will investigate. If the circumstances merit, we may ask the appropriate authorities to investigate misuse of the facility.

Where a user is found to be abusing the facilities by carrying about any of the above actions, he/she will be excluded from using the ICT facilities provided by SAES.

If you alight on a site that you consider may be offensive to other users or receive e-mail that may be considered offensive if viewed by other users please alert SAES staff who will take the appropriate action to prevent further access.

By clicking yes you are agreeing to the terms detailed above. If you do not agree to these terms, you will be unable to access the ITC facilities offered by SAES.
