

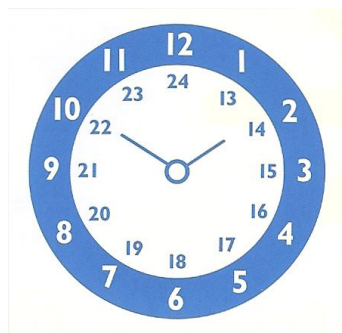
The Joint Public Transport Group supplies and maintains roadside timetable information cases throughout the Middlesbrough, Stockton and Redcar and Cleveland areas. These are kept fully up to date, and are a great help to people using bus services.

Bus stop plates are also provided at bus stops, and kept up to date with service numbers in instances where not every bus passing a stop serves it. If no numbers are shown on the stop, then all buses passing that stop should use it. Such plates are progressively being marked “ **ALL SERVICES** “ or “ **ALL SERVICES EXCEPT EXPRESS** “ (where limited stop services do not observe the stop) to emphasise the fact.

But the provision of these timetable frames and bus stop plates rely on YOUR help – **So PLEASE:**

- ✓ Report any acts of vandalism you may witness immediately to the police.
- ✓ If you notice any damaged, vandalised or incorrect timetable Information on display anywhere in Middlesbrough, Stockton or Redcar and Cleveland, let us know by Informing us at the address on page 1, or by telephoning the Joint Public Transport Group on **(08456) 126 126** extension **2555**.
We will then do our best to correct this as soon as possible.

However the Joint Public Transport Group cannot take or accept any responsibility for incorrect times or the failure to operate any journey. Please note that, in many cases, the times shown in the timetable information frames are estimated from timing points elsewhere on the route, so please arrive at your stop in good time (at least 5 minutes before is recommended). It should also be noted that the law allows bus operators to introduce, amend or withdraw a service at eight weeks' notice to the Traffic Commissioner, or less in certain circumstances.

The timetable in this book and in the information in the roadside timetable displays. Instead of using am and pm to identify morning and afternoon/evening, journey times after midday have 12 added to them. For example, 2pm is shown as 1400; 8.30pm is shown as 2030. times shown before midday are shown as 0830 (8.30am), 1100 (1100am).

The clock shown here gives the time as 0150 hours in the morning (1.50am) or 1350 hours in the afternoon (1.50pm).
