**Writing in Greater Depth at KS1**

**Key Stage:** KS1

**Who is it for?**

KS1 Teachers

**What are the benefits?**

The criteria for attaining Greater Depth within the standard for writing at the end of KS1 are demanding. What kind of writing experiences do young, able writers need in order to become more effective? Does your current KS1 writing curriculum provide these experiences?

This half day course will support teachers from across KS1 to unpick the concept of 'mastery' in writing and how this applies in KS1. We will consider how to adapt the writing curriculum and the teaching sequence for writing in order to help all pupils make good progress and ensure that the most able are encouraged to demonstrate their ability to write at greater depth.

**Objectives:**

- secure an understanding of what the national curriculum expects in terms of teaching and learning in writing at KS1;
- consider approaches to structuring an effective writing curriculum to build skills and understanding;
- develop an understanding of the importance of editing and redrafting – and the marking and feedback practice which supports it;
- consider the links between reading and writing and how to ensure that books are used to support a growing understanding of vocabulary and grammar.
