

IMPORTANT NOTE: PARKING CHARGES NOW APPLY IN OFF STREET CAR PARKS

From Monday 28 April 2014 charges became applicable for registered Blue Badge holders parking off-street in any Stockton Borough Council managed car park, where charges apply. Charges apply in general and dedicated “disabled” parking bays in long and short stay car parks. Charges do not apply to on street parking.

This change is part of a Borough Wide Car Parking Strategy outlining how flexible parking tariffs, car parking promotions and parking management can support the economic development and regeneration aspirations for the Borough.

A permitted overstay’ concession does allow the time on the ticket to over-run by ONE HOUR if a valid Blue Badge is correctly displayed. This means in a short stay off street car park, no matter if you are parked in a general bay, or a designated disabled bay a penalty charge would not be issued for up to an hour after the expiry time on the ticket - providing that a valid Blue Badge is correctly displayed.

Charges in short stay car parks in Stockton town centre are currently Monday to Saturday between 9am and 5pm, first hour is free, £1 for 2 hours and £1 per hour thereafter.

When parking in Yarm town centre:

Charges DO NOT APPLY on Yarm High Street for those correctly displaying a valid Blue Badge. You may park free of charge in a general bay or designated Disabled bay for as long as you need to.

If you park in a Council managed long stay off street car park in Yarm town centre charges do apply. The off street charges are currently Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm £1.50 all day.
