ADOPTION STATEMENT

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England)

Regulations 2012

In accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council adopted the Statement of Community Involvement on 17 November 2016.

This document replaces the Statement of Community Involvement (2006) and Statement of Community Involvement Update (2013). It sets out Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council's policies for involving interested parties in matters relating to development in their area. It applies to:

- The preparation and revision of the Council's Local Plan and Supplementary Planning Documents, which are also known as Local Development Documents.
- The Authority's development management function, which involves the determination of planning applications.

Any such application must be made promptly in any event no later than 3 months after the date on which the document was adopted.
