## 6. Eligibility - Circumstances in which a person is not eligible to be a governor.

**Governors must be 18 years or over at the time of their election or appointment.**

**A person is disqualified from holding or continuing to hold office as a governor or associate member if they:**

- Are subject to a bankruptcy restrictions order, an interim bankruptcy restrictions order, a debt relief restrictions order or an interim debt relief restrictions order;
- Have had their estate sequestrated (temporarily repossessed) and the sequestration has not been discharged, annulled or reduced;
- Have been removed from the office of trustee for a charity by an order made by the Charity Commissioners or the High Court on the grounds of any misconduct or mismanagement in the administration of the charity for which I was responsible or to which I was privy, or to which I contributed or which I facilitated by my conduct;
- Have been removed, under section 34 of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 (a) (Powers of Court of Session) from being concerned in the management or control of anybody;
- Are subject to a disqualification order or disqualification undertaking under the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986, the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 or the Company Directors Disqualification (Northern Ireland) Order 2002;
- Are subject to an order made under section 429(2)(b) of the Insolvency Act 1986 (e) (*failure to pay under county court administration order*);
- Are disqualified from registration under Part 10A of the Children Act 1989 for child-minding or providing day care or disqualified from registration under Part 3 of the Childcare Act 2006;
- Have in the five years prior to becoming a governor or since becoming a governor received a sentence of imprisonment, suspended or otherwise, for a period of not less than three months without the option of a fine;
- Have in the twenty years prior to becoming a governor, been convicted as aforesaid of any offence and had passed on me a sentence of imprisonment for a period of not less than two and a half years;
- Have at any time, had passed a sentence of imprisonment for a period of not less than five years;
- Have in the five years prior to becoming a governor or since being appointed as a governor been sentenced to a fine for causing a nuisance or disturbance on school or educational premises;
- Are subject to any direction or prohibition which prevents me from working with children.
