People invest in home alarm systems because they want to keep themselves, their family and their home safe from intruders. Extensive studies on alarm systems have shown that residential burglar alarm systems decrease crime, with 60% of convicted burglars stating that the presence of a security system influenced their decision to target a different home.

- It simply makes the location less appealing to would-be and active intruders.

Other studies have found:

- Most criminals burgle a home in less than 10 minutes.
- 34% of burglars enter through the front door and go straight to the master bedroom.
- 70% of home invasions occur when someone is not home.
- Most burglaries take place between the day hours of 10 a.m. and 3 p.m
