



## **Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities Order 2020**

*Made 24th February 2020  
Coming into force on Monday 30th March 2020*

Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council in exercise of its powers conferred by section 33A (2) of the Traffic Management Act 2004, The Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (as amended) and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following order -

1. This Order may be cited as Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities Order 2020 and shall come into force on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2020
2. Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council acting as the Local Highway Authority for all streets under its control within the whole area encompassed by the authority's boundary approves the Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities which is set out in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities set out in the Schedule to this Order complies with all aspects of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, with all other primary and secondary legislation in relation to Traffic Management Permit Schemes, and does not exceed the powers provided under such legislation.
4. The Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities set out in the Schedule to this Order comes into effect on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2020
5. Part 8 of the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007 (as amended) shall apply to the specified streets within the Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council Permit Scheme for Road and Street Activities.
