The Licensing Act 2003 (Fees) Regulations 2005 Specify The Fees And Charges That Are Applicable In Relation To The Application And Grant Of Licences Under The Licensing Act 2003.			
The Fees For Premises And Club Premises Certificates Are Based On The Rateable Value Of The Premise As Detailed In The Table Below.

EXEMPTIONS
Applications For Premises Licences/Club Premises Certificates, Which Relate To The Provision Of Regulated Entertainment Only – NO FEE Is Payable Where:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Application Is By A Proprietor Of An Educational Institution In Respect Of Premises That Are Or Form Part Of An Educational Establishment; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (a) The Establishment Is A School Or College; (b) The Provision Of Regulated Entertainment On The Premises Is Carried On By The Establishment For And On Behalf Of That Establishment; Or 2. The Application Is In Respect Of Premises That Are Or Form Part Of A Church Hall, Chapel Hall Or Similar Building Or A Village Hall, Parish Hall Or Other Similar Building. <p>Additionally, No Annual Fee Is Payable Under The Above Exemption.</p>

The Licensing Authorities Will Also Be Able To Charge Other Fees In Relation To Their Duties, Most Notably For Temporary Events And Personal Licences.
