

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**STOCKTON ON TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL
PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO. 7 (INGLEBY BARWICK)
& PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY NO.3 (INGLEBY BARWICK) (IN PARTS)
DIVERSION ORDER 2021**

The above order was made on 26th August 2021. The effect of the Order will be to divert the public bridleway running from land off Roundhill Avenue, Ingleby Barwick at GR NZ 4362 1354 at point 'A' on drawing H117-285 for 570m and create an alternative bridleway instead from the same point 'A' but proceeding in a south westerly direction for 17m to point 'B' then in a westerly direction for 250m to point 'C' then in a northerly direction for 220m to point 'D' then in a north easterly direction for 90m to point 'E' at GR NZ 4333 1382 as shown on the Order Map (H117/285).

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees, TS18 1LD between the hours 10am – 1pm and between 2pm – 4.30pm Monday to Friday and on the Council's website (traffic orders). Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at the price of £2.00.

Any representation about or objection to the Order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to Highway Network and Flood Risk Manager, Community Services and Transport Directorate, Kingsway House, Billingham, TS23 2YL not later than 27th September 2021. Please state the grounds on which it is made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
