Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council has secured National Lottery Heritage Fund money to improve the historic environment of the northern end of Stockton High Street. As part of this project, Tees Archaeology is working with the Council to provide the opportunity for local people to take part in an archaeological excavation on the site of the 19th century Congregational Church on the corner of Norton Road and Tennant Street.

The project will examine the archaeological evidence for the chapel and investigate earlier activity on the site. The project will be carried out by volunteers who will be trained in all aspects of archaeological excavation and will be led by Janice Adams and Robin Daniels of Tees Archaeology and supported by the Townscape Heritage project team. There will be an Open Day on Saturday 2 October. The project base will be on Stockton High Street.

No previous experience is necessary, but you should be aware that the project will be outdoors and you will need to dress accordingly. Refreshments will be provided, however you will need to provide your own lunch. The working day will be 9.30am to 4.00pm with appropriate rest breaks.

COVID 19 - We will be putting appropriate measures in place to ensure the project is delivered in a safe way within current guidelines and will discuss this in more detail with those who book for the project. COVID 19 does mean that the numbers who can work each day will be limited to six.
