

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES  
ENVIRONMENTAL 7.5 TONNE WEIGHT RESTRICTION  
(AMENDMENT NO.2) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made the above Order on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2021 under Sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order, which will come into effect on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 2021 will have the effect of creating a new weight limit restriction along the length of road specified in the Schedule below.

The Order, together with a map showing the affected roads, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees between the hours 10am – 1pm and between 2pm – 4.30pm Monday to Friday and on the council's website (Traffic Orders).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 24<sup>th</sup> September 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

**SCHEDULE – New 7.5 Tonne Weight Limit**

**A1046 Port Clarence Road** – Between its junctions with Haverton Hill Road / Hope Street and A178 Seaton Carew Road.
