

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2004
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021**

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 25th day of October 2021 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, A67, High Street / The Spital / Worsall Road, Yarm, Stockton-on-Tees)(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2004 Amendment Order 2021.
2. The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (A67, High Street / The Spital / Worsall Road, Yarm, Stockton-on-Tees) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2004 (“the 2004 Order”) shall be amended as follows but shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
 - (1) The words specified in Schedule 1 hereto are to be deleted from Schedule 1 of the 2004 Order.
 - (2) The words specified in Schedule 2 hereto are to be inserted into Schedule 2 of the 2004 Order.

SCHEDULE 1

Wording to be deleted from Schedule 1 of the 2004 Order – ‘No Waiting between 8.00am to 9.00am and 4.00pm to 5.00pm (Monday to Friday)’

Road	Length
A67 The Spital, Yarm (west side)	From its junction with B1265 Worsall Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 355 metres.
A67 The Spital, Yarm (east side)	From its junction with B1265 Worsall Road in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 259 metres. From its junction with Goose Pastures in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 67 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

Wording to be inserted into Schedule 2 of the 2004 Order – ‘No Waiting at any time’

Road	Length
A67 The Spital, Yarm (west side)	Between its junctions with B1265 Worsall Road and The Pines. From its junction with The Pines in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.
A67 The Spital, Yarm (east side)	From its junction with Goose Pasture in a northerly direction for a distance of

	approximately 259 metres. From its junction with Goose Pasture in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 67 metres.
The Pines, Yarm (south side)	From its junction with A67 The Spital in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.
The Pines, Yarm (north side)	From its junction with A67 The Spital in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres.

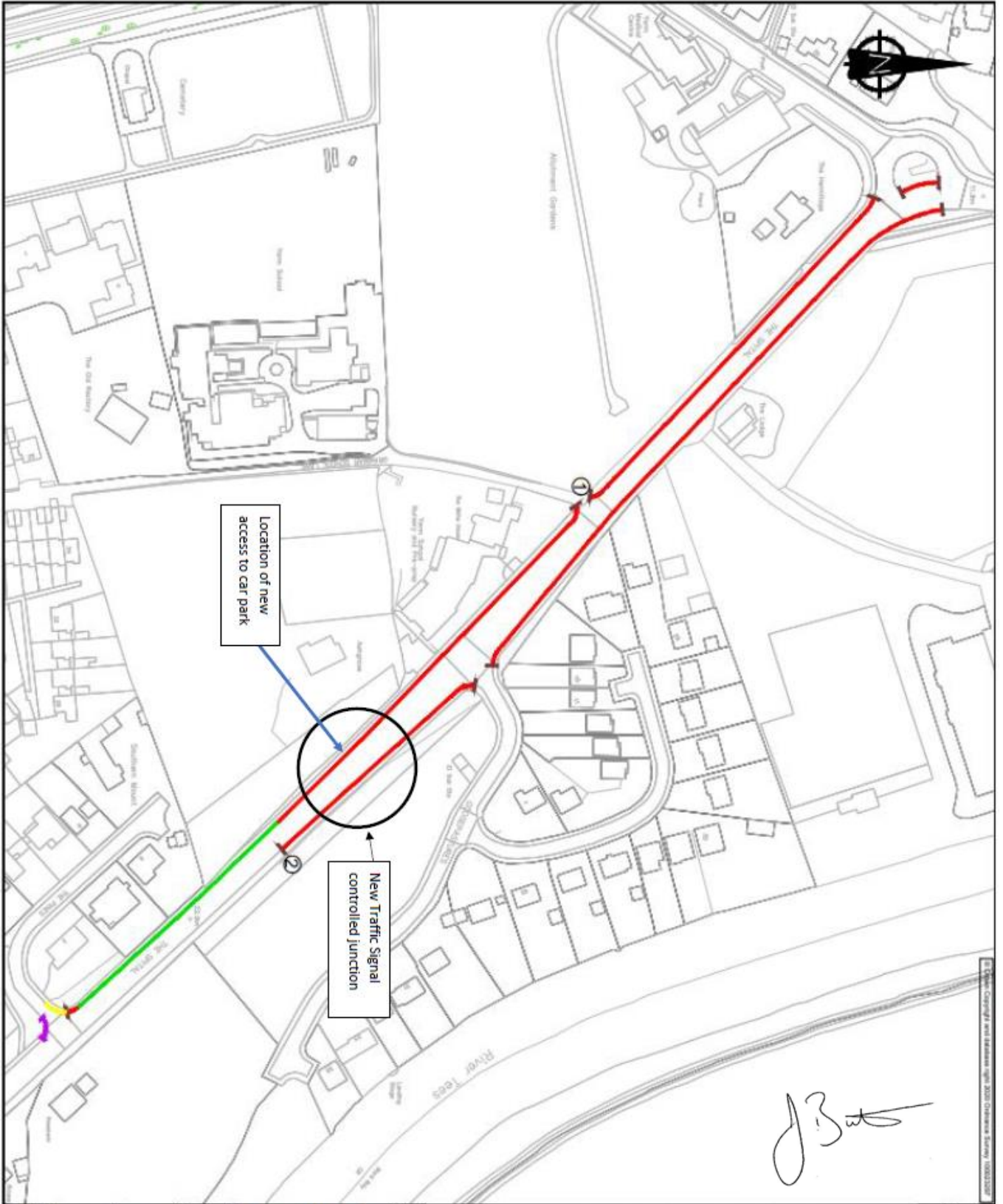

NOTES

- 1. Existing single yellow line to be removed to enable yellow line D (only 1 contraction street).
- 2. Existing road edge after side of white top edge and has displaced kerbside.
- 3. Yellow kerbside 'T' line at the end of double yellow line to indicate 'TWO' change. Also to be removed where of yellow line double yellow line, extended to 'The Drive' to permit parking on approach to new asphalt square D1713 construction work.
- 4. Where it crosses on 'The Drive' to merge but it existing on 'The Spial' to be replaced with double yellow line.
- 5. Where it is crossing to be replaced by double yellow line. Where it crosses 'The Spial' and 'The Drive' to permit 'The Spial'.
- 6. 1. Laying to stop at end of proposed highway.
- 7. 2. Double yellow line stop when existing cycle lane marking ends.
