

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
COWPEN BEWLEY ROAD, BILLINGHAM
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council propose to make an Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order will have the effect of reducing the speed limit along the length of road specified in Schedule 1 from National (60mph) to 40mph.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the affected roads and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees between the hours 10am – 1pm and between 2pm – 4.30pm Monday-Friday and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders). If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to Transport Strategy and Road Safety Manager, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, PO Box 229, Kingsway House, West Precinct, Billingham, TS23 2YL or HTD@Stockton.gov.uk by 5 November 2021.

SCHEDULE 1

Proposed 40mph Speed Limit (reduction from National 60mph)

Cowpen Bewley Road, Billingham – From the 30mph gateway to Cowpen Bewley Village, located approximately 220 metres north of the junction with Macklin Avenue to a point approximately 580 metres to the south of the 30mph gateway.
