

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
BARLEY FIELDS AND ST THERESE OF LISIEUX, INGLEBY BARWICK
SCHOOL TIME WAITING RESTRCITIONS ORDER 2018 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made the above Order on 22nd October 2021 under Sections 1, 2, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order, which will come into effect on 29th October 2021, will have the effect of prohibiting any vehicle waiting or loading at any time along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 below.

The Order, together with a map showing the affected roads, may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees between the hours 10am – 1pm and between 2pm – 4.30pm Monday to Friday and on the council's website (Traffic Orders).

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 22nd October 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1 – Proposed no waiting between 8.00am until 9.30am and 2.30pm until 4.00pm

Rothbury Close, Ingleby Barwick (east side) – From a point approximately 10 metres south of its junction with Blair Avenue in a southerly direction for an approximate distance of 100 metres (including the turning head).

Rothbury Close, Ingleby Barwick (west side) – From a point approximately 10 metres south of its junction with Blair Avenue in a southerly direction for an approximate distance of 55 metres.

Rothbury Close, Ingleby Barwick (west fork, east side) – From the driveway access of 34 Rothbury Close in a north/east direction for a distance of approximately 20 metres.
