

Preston Park Dog Control Areas

During the summer of 2011, a voluntary dog control scheme was put in place in the park and the comments of park users were sought. Generally the scheme was welcomed and no major dog related incidents occurred.

This scheme will continue on a voluntary basis with some changes to address issues raised during the consultation, as follows:-

- 1 The original dogs on lead area has been limited to the main field.
- 2 Quarry Wood Local Nature Reserve has been clarified as a dogs on lead area, in order to protect plants in this wildlife area.
- 3 Dogs are not allowed at all in the children's play area or in other buildings and enclosed areas where public access is restricted.

The need for Compulsory Dog Control Areas will be reviewed annually, based on the level of incidents reported.
