## Dog Control Areas

During May and June 2012, a voluntary dog control scheme was proposed in the park and the comments of park users were sought.

This scheme will be implemented, still on a voluntary basis including some changes to address issues raised during the consultation, as follows:-

1. The area where dogs are allowed off lead has been increased to include all the southern part of the park.
2. The areas have been kept as simple as possible to make it clear for all park users where dogs should and should not be on a lead.
3. Dogs are still not allowed at all in the children's play area, the bowling green or in other buildings and enclosed areas where public access is restricted.

The need for Compulsory Dog Control Areas will be reviewed annually, based on need due to the level of incidents reported.
