

Cowpen Bewley Woodland Park Dog Control Areas

During the summer of 2011, a voluntary dog control scheme was put in place in the park and the comments of park users were sought. Generally users agreed the need for some control on dogs but only during the summer months.

Conclusions were as follows:-

- 1 There was no need for restrictions over the winter.
- 2 Dogs should be kept on a lead in the fields around the visitor centre and lake between April and September.
- 3 The scheme will remain voluntary and the need for Compulsory Dog Control Areas will be reviewed annually based on the level of incidents.



Summer Controls

From 1st April until 30th September dog walkers using the park are requested to keep their dogs on lead whilst in the car park and fields around the visitor centre and lake as identified on the map opposite.

In all other areas dogs may be off lead providing they remain under the control of their handler.

Winter Controls

From 1st October until 31st March there are no dog control restrictions in place providing the dogs remain under control of their handler particularly in the car park area.

The areas have been introduced in order to balance the needs of all users of the park. It is aimed at reducing incidents of dogs being aggressive to other dogs or park users as well as protecting wildlife in the park.

Please ensure that you and your dog comply when in the respective area.
