

**STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL
PENNYDARREN WAY, INGLEBY BARWICK
TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME**

In accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999, Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council hereby give notice of its proposal to introduce a traffic calming scheme, namely the construction of three road humps on Pennydarren Way, Ingleby Barwick. The location of the road humps is specified in the Schedule below. The humps shall have an approach gradient of 1:15 that will not exceed 75mm in height with +/- 10% tolerance.

Approximately 34 metres south of the junction with The Rings to side of 4/35 Pennydarren Way

Approximately 12 metres north of the junction with Port Way outside 14/16 Pennydarren Way

Approximately 73 metres south of the junction with Port Way
