

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
ELDON STREET, THORNABY, STOCKTON-ON-TEES
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 92 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. For the purposes of this Order the terms described in this Article shall have the meanings specified:
 - (a) **"Vehicle"** means a motor vehicle, a passenger vehicle, a dual-purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle, a motorcycle or an invalid carriage or any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal, mechanical or electrical power;
 - (b) **"Pedal Cycle"** means a unicycle, bicycle, tricycle, or cycle having four or more wheels, not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as is to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Act.
2. This Order shall come into operation on the xxxxxxxxxxxx and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, Eldon Street, Thornaby, Stockton-On-Tees Traffic Regulation Order 2022.
3. Save as is hereinafter provided, no person shall, at any time except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any Vehicle, except a Pedal Cycle to enter or proceed along the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order. This prohibition includes an obstruction in accordance with Section 92 of the Act.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle to travel along any part of the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely –
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations, subject to obtaining the prior written consent of the Council;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of roads, or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said sides of the roads, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunication Act 1984.
 - (b) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting "postal packets" as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000.
 - (d) any vehicle being used for fire brigade purposes, or which is an ambulance or a vehicle in the service of a local authority, statutory undertakers or police force, in any case being used in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.

Prohibition of Driving – all motor vehicles prohibited

Road	Length
Eldon Street, Thornaby, Stockton-On-Tees	From its junction with Cobden Street in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 3 metres.

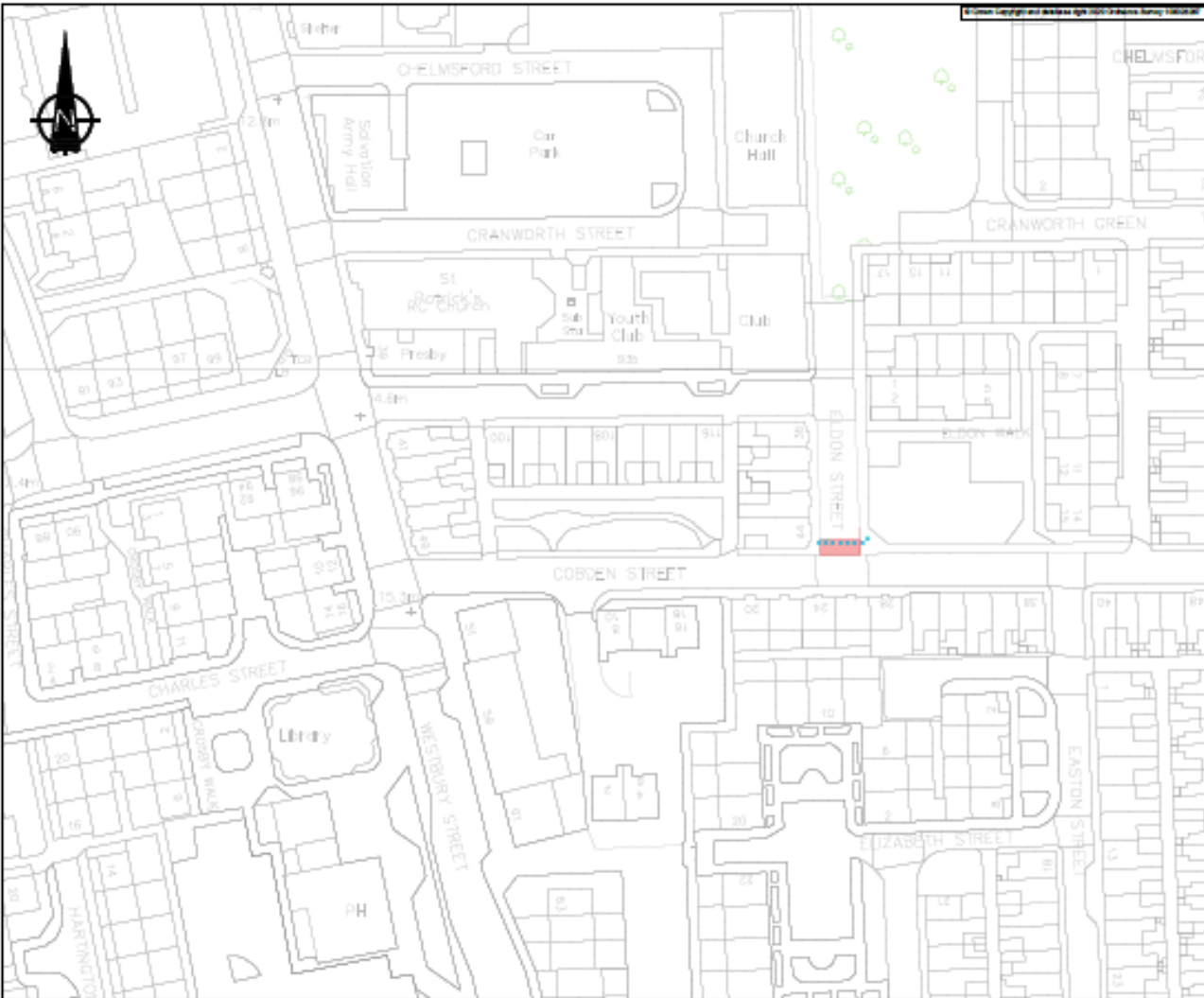
