

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES  
HIGH LANE, MALTBY, STOCKTON-ON-TEES  
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2022**

The Council of the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the **XX** day of **XXXX** 2022 and may be cited as The Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, High Lane, Maltby, Stockton-on-Tees, Traffic Regulation Order 2022.
2. No person shall, at any time cause or permit a motor vehicle to enter or proceed along the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. The Borough of Stockton on Tees (A1044 Low Lane Thornaby and High Lane, Maltby, Stockton-on-Tees) (Speed Limit Reduction) Order 2003 (Amendment No.2) Order 2021 ("the 2021 Order") shall be amended as follows but shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.
  - (1) The following words specified in Schedule 2 – New Schedule 2 to be added to the 2003 Order are to be deleted from the 2021 Order:

*"High Lane, Maltby*

*From its junction with A1044 Low Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 767 metres."*

And replaced with the following words:

*"High Lane, Maltby*

*From a point approximately 46 metres east of its junction with A1044 Low Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 721 metres."*

**Schedule 1  
Prohibition of Driving – all motor vehicles prohibited**

High Lane, Maltby, Stockton-on-Tees	From its junction with A1044 Low Lane in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 46 metres.
