

**STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL
HIGH STREET, NORTON
TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME**

In accordance with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999, Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council hereby give notice of its proposal to introduce a traffic calming scheme, namely the construction of a flat top road hump at the existing Puffin crossing facility on High Street, Norton. The flat top road hump will be located approximately 20 metres northwest of its junction with High Street/Darlington Lane roundabout. The hump will be a 6 metre plateau with an approach gradient of 1:15 that will not exceed 75mm in height with +/- 10% tolerance. The hump will convert the area into a 'Humped Puffin crossing'.

Plans showing the proposed scheme may be viewed on the Council's website (search for Traffic Orders). If you wish to object to the proposals, you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to Transport Strategy and Road Safety Manager, Stockton on Tees Borough Council, PO Box 229, Kingsway House, West Precinct, Billingham, TS23 2YL or HTD@stockton.gov.uk by 10th October 2022.
