

**STOCKTON-ON-TEES BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TRENCHARD AVENUE, THORNABY**

Notice is hereby given that Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 and Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 intend to provide the pedestrian crossings and road humps as detailed in the schedules below.

Plans showing the proposed scheme may be examined by contacting Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal opening hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders). If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to Transport Planning and Strategy Manager, Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council, Dunedin House, Columbia Drive, Thornaby, Stockton-on-Tees, TS17 6BJ or HTD@Stockton.gov.uk by 15th August 2025.

Schedule 1 – Installation of new staggered Toucan Crossing

Trenchard Avenue, Thornaby - From it a point approximately 76 metres south of its junction with Mitchell Avenue/Milbank Lane roundabout.

Schedule 2 – Installation of new Raised Junction

Redcar Road, Thornaby – From its junction with junction with Humber Road in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 9 metres. The flat top road hump will be a 9 metre plateau with an approach gradient of 1:20 that will not exceed 75 mm in height, +/- 10% tolerance.
