Local Councillors are the people you elect, usually every four years, to represent your interests in local affairs. Each Councillor represents a small area, or ward, and its inhabitants. The Borough has 26 such wards with either one, two or three Councillors representing each.

There are 56 Councillors in total in the Borough of Stockton.

The current political parties/associations represented are: Conservative Party, Ingleby Barwick Independent Society, Labour Party, Liberal Democrat Party, Thornaby Independent Association and West Words.

All Councillors arrange regular 'Ward Surgeries', where you can drop in without an appointment to informally discuss problems or other matters concerning your neighbourhood.

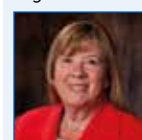

How decisions are made - the Council's Cabinet & Committees

The way Council decisions in Stockton are made reflects in many ways those that are used in Westminster.

In the same way that MPs are involved in national decision-making, the most important decisions locally are taken by Councillors, each elected by local people. Councillors rely on advice from professional Council officers, who then have the task of implementing their decisions. In some cases, officers are also able to make routine decisions on day-to-day matters within guidelines delegated by Councillors.

Council Meetings

Major Council policies and strategies are set at meetings of all 56 elected Councillors at Stockton Town Hall, which take place ten times a year. For example, the full Council must agree the Council Plan for the next three year period, setting out the Council's key improvement plans which contribute to the Borough's Community Strategy. Councillors may also debate a wide variety of topical issues.

Meetings of the full Council are open to the public and include a public question time. Questions need to be submitted in advance (at least seven working days).

Decisions on how to implement these policies are made by a seven strong **Cabinet** of Councillors which meet every four weeks. It is able to plan services and

take decisions which affect a broad range of services.

The Cabinet is made up of the Leader of the Council and six other Councillors, each responsible for a particular area of work and most Cabinet meetings take place at Stockton Central Library.

Cabinet decisions (and key decisions by officers) are subject to examination by the Council's **Executive Scrutiny Committee**. Five **Select Committees** also play an important part in this process. Each has a particular area of expertise and monitors and evaluates the way in which the Council works and the ways in which its policies are being implemented and developed.

There are also a small number of other committees and panels which are of a statutory nature (eg **Planning Committee** and **Licensing Committee**).

Anyone is welcome at Council, Cabinet and Committee meetings, although you may be asked to leave when certain confidential items are discussed.
