

**THE BOROUGH OF STOCKTON-ON-TEES
WELLINGTON STREET, STOCKTON
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2026**

Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council made the above Order on 11th March 2026 under Sections 1, 2, 4 & Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The Order, which will come into effect on 13th March 2026, relates to various lengths of Wellington Street, Stockton and the unnamed road between Wellington Square car park and Wellington Street, and will have the effect of revoking existing restrictions and introducing new no waiting and no loading at any time restrictions, no waiting at any time restrictions except Hackney Carriages, a designated loading bay between the hours of 3am and 5pm on any day and a hackney carriage stand between the hours of 5pm and 3am on any day.

The Order and map showing the affected roads may be examined at the Stockton Customer Service Centre, Central Library, The Square, Stockton-on-Tees during normal office hours and on the Council's website (Traffic Orders). If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under them has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 11th March 2026 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
